



Summer free school meals and activities

Summer school meals and activities

This summer, parents of children eligible for free school meals will have two separate schemes to make the most of to help feed their children during the school holiday.

Weeks one and six 26th-30th July and 30th August-3rd September

For the first and last week of the holiday, parents will receive vouchers to use in supermarkets worth £15 per child, per week. The vouchers will be sent between the 14th and 16th July for the total amount for both weeks. For example, if you have two children, you will receive one voucher worth £60. These are funded through Covid emergency funding and grants.

Weeks two to four 2nd-27th August (excluding weekends)

Parents can sign their child(ren) up for the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme. This four-week programme is coordinated by Gloucestershire County Council, and funded by the Department for Education. We're teaming up with district councils, the voluntary sector, and other partner organisations to offer daily face-to-face or virtual activities to keep children safe, active, entertained and fed during these four weeks.

Each district's activities will have opportunities for either meals or food kits.
